



## Nomination and Selection Procedure for TNRHA Hall of Fame

### People

Any TNRHA member can nominate a person to the Hall of Fame by submitting criteria information to the TNRHA Board of Directors.

Nominees will be screened by the board (or committee appointed by the president). Emphasis will be placed on meaningful contributions to, and longevity in, the association rather than on personal accomplishments. Membership in the TNRHA Hall of Fame is a means of honoring the members without whose efforts TNRHA could not grow and exist.

Deadline for nominations is April 1st.

### Horses

Any TNRHA member can nominate a horse meeting the criteria for nomination for the Hall of Fame by submitting the information listed below to the TNRHA Board of Directors.

Nominees will be screened by the board (or committee appointed by the president) with emphasis placed on the following criteria:

- a. Older horses should have preference over younger horses.
- b. The horse should be evaluated based on the enjoyment and excitement they have provided competitors and spectators alike either through their own accomplishments or those of their offspring.
- c. Selection for the Hall of Fame should never be used to promote or publicize a particular bloodline for commercial gain but rather to honor the contribution to the enjoyment and improvement of reining in Tennessee.

Deadline for nominations is April 1st.

4. show record
5. special influences

#### Horses

1. show record
2. show record of get
3. special influences
4. special honors awarded
5. current or last owner
